AMENDMENT TO THE PLANNING BOARD ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FOUR OAKS

WHEREAS, the Town of Four Oaks Planning Board has recommended an amendment to the Town of Four Oaks Planning Board Ordinance, as described below, and finds it reasonable; and

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town of Four Oaks Board of Commissioners as follows:

- The amendment to the Town of Four Oaks Planning Board Ordinance, as described below, was reviewed, and recommends approval by the Board of Commissioners on Monday February 17, 2025.
- 2. Amend planning board ordinance language for Section 32.01 as follows:

Section 32.01 Planning Board - Members; Terms; Vacancies

- (A) The Planning Board shall consist of seven members, four of whom shall be citizens of the town and three of whom shall be residents of the county, residing in the town's area of extraterritorial jurisdiction. The Town's Board of Commissioners shall appoint four members from the town and recommend three members from the area of extraterritorial jurisdiction to be appointed by the County Board. In the event the County Board fails to make the appointments requested within 90 days of receipt of the request, the Town's Board of Commissioners shall make the appointments.
- (B) Two members of the town and two members from the extraterritorial area shall be appointed for three-year terms, two members from the town and one-member from the extraterritorial area shall be appointed for two-year terms. New appointments shall be made for two-year terms as these terms expire. Vacancies occurring for reasons other than expiration of terms shall be filled for the unexpired term only, by the legislative body responsible for the original appointment.

This ordinance amendment shall be effective immediately on the 17th day of February 2025.
